 through twelfth grade coordinating Chapel services, community service initiatives and
 other campus ministry programs
- 2. providing pastoral counseling to students individually and in small groups, meeting with them to offer guidance and encouragement in their Christian walk

Well-suited candidates have an evident devotion to the Lord and an abiding love for students. They are accomplished leaders and gifted teachers, with experience caring for and counseling students in all stages of their faith journey, as well as overseeing a range of campus ministry programs. They are mature in their Christian faith and theological reflection with an imagination for fostering a culture of deep engagement in worship, prayer, the study of Scripture and the ministry of compassionate care and service to others. Familiarity with The Book of Common Prayer and affection for Christian liturgy through the Church year will be essential for success in this role.

The Director of Discipleship and Campus Ministry serves as a member of the leadership team, reports to the Head of School and works closely with Division Principals and community ministry leaders as well as faculty and staff from a range of Christian traditions to shepherd the central pillar of faith at the very heart of our school's mission and strategic priorities.

This role requires flexible, enthusiastic collaboration, detail-oriented management, and superb communication skills. A Bachelor's degree is required. A Master's degree and 5 or more years of ministry experience are preferred.

This year-round position begins July 2022. Salary and benefits are competitive, and the work environment is collegial.
