



Health Form Frequently Asked Questions

To: All Parents of St. David's School Students

At St. David's School, it is our desire to provide a safe and healthy environment for learning. Your careful attention to the following helps us to meet this goal effectively. **Please read carefully and note that ALL forms are online and due to Magnus Health, our online medical record database, by August 1st.** School will not accept any forms, however, parents may upload forms directly into their student's file or mail or fax to Magnus. Failure to complete required forms will result in your child being restricted from attending school.

VITAL HEALTH RECORD

Who? All students, renewed annually.

Please include **all** current medications, even those not taken during the school day. There are no paper forms that require signatures; you will complete this section online.

CONSENT TO TREAT

Who? All students, renewed annually.

This online form requires an electronic parent signature authorizing emergency treatment for your child. Updated parent signature required every year.

IMMUNIZATION FORM

Who? All new students (including Pre-K), all Kindergartners; all 7th graders.

Immunizations are required as per North Carolina State Law. Pre-K students will submit age-appropriate immunizations. **All 7th graders** are required to submit proof of Tdap booster and Meningococcal vaccine.

ANNUAL PHYSICAL EXAM FORM

Who? All new students (including Pre-K and K);

All students who wish to participate in athletics; renewed annually.

(Athletic physicals expire 12 months from the date of the last physical on file. Athletes with expired physicals will not be permitted to try out, practice, or play.)

OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICATION FORM

Who? All students, renewed annually.

If you would like your student to have access to OTC medication during the school day, you must complete this form which requires ***both parent and physician signatures*** for the first year of completion. Online parent signatures are required annually to keep this form valid after the initial year of completion. If you do not want your child to have access to our OTC medications, only a parent signature is required. The nurse's office stocks acetaminophen, ibuprofen, Midol, Benadryl, Tums, cough drops, Polysporin, hydrocortisone cream, burn cream and lubricant eye drops.

Please be aware that NO MEDICATION will be dispensed to your child without written authorization from a parent and physician.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION FORM

Who? Any student who will need prescription medication dispensed during the school day, renewed annually.

This includes medications for asthma, diabetes, or other chronic conditions. These medications must be brought to the school nurse on the first day of school, unless the student has been approved by parent and physician to self-medicate (as in the use of an asthma inhaler). The form is required whether the medication is self-administered or given by the nurse.

CONCUSSION INFORMATION FORM

Who? Any student who will participate in contact sports, renewed annually.

This online form is signed electronically by both the student and parent.

ALLERGY, DIABETES, ASTHMA, SEIZURE PLANS

Who? Any student with a health issue that may need to be addressed during the school day.

An Action Plan needs to be submitted with ***signatures from both parent and physician*** on an annual basis.
